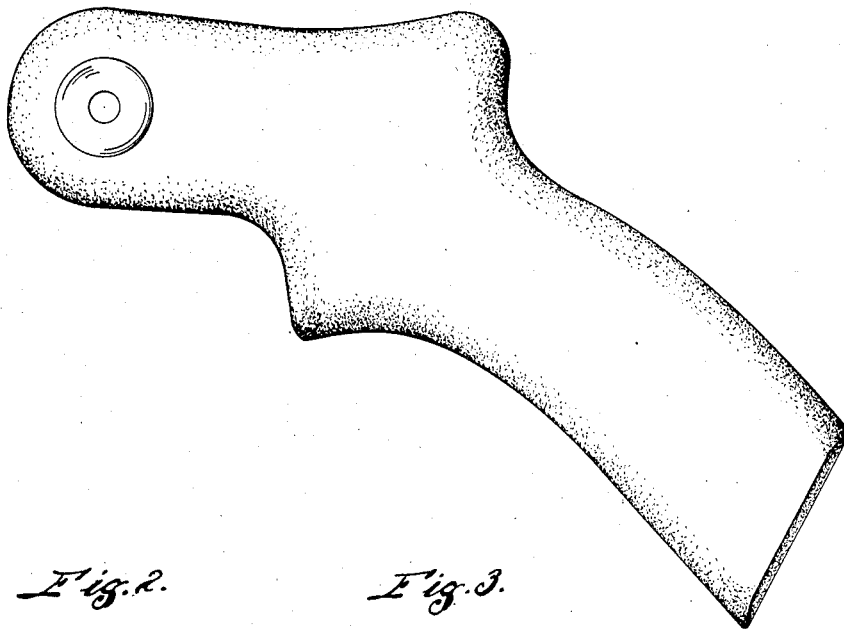

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Frank R. Weaver, a citizen of the United States, residing at Indianapolis, in the county of Marion and State of Indiana, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Saw Handle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevation of a saw handle showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is an elevation of the handle viewed from the saw receiving end thereof; and

Fig. 3 an elevation of the handle viewed from the butt end thereof.
