


DESIGN FOR A SAW HANDLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known, that I, Frank Weaver, a citizen of the United States, residing at Indianapolis, in the county of Marion and State of Indiana, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Saw Handle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a saw handle, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

Fig. 3 is a sectional view taken substantially on the line 3—3 of Fig. 1 and looking in the direction of the arrows; and

Fig. 4 is a sectional view thereof taken substantially on the line 4—4 of Fig. 1 and looking in the direction of the arrows.
