

DESIGN FOR A SAW-HANDLE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 33,617, dated November 27, 1900.

Application filed August 15, 1900. Serial No. 26,995. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EDWIN F. SHAW; a citizen of the United States, residing in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented and produced a certain new and original Design for Saw-Handles, of which the following is a specification.

My design for a saw-handle is clearly illustrated in the accompanying drawing, the figure of which illustrates the handle in perspective.

The essential feature of the design is the handle having laterally-extending flanges at

the upper and lower edges thereof.

A is the handle, having undulating upper and lower edges and an eye a. This eye forms a handhold a'. The handle has a grooved

end a^2 , partly curved. Projecting on each side of the upper edge of the handle is a flange b, and projecting on each side of the lower 20 edge of the handle is a flange b'. The flanges conform to the undulating upper and lower edges, as shown.

Ì claim-

The design for a saw-handle as herein described and as illustrated in the accompanying drawing.
