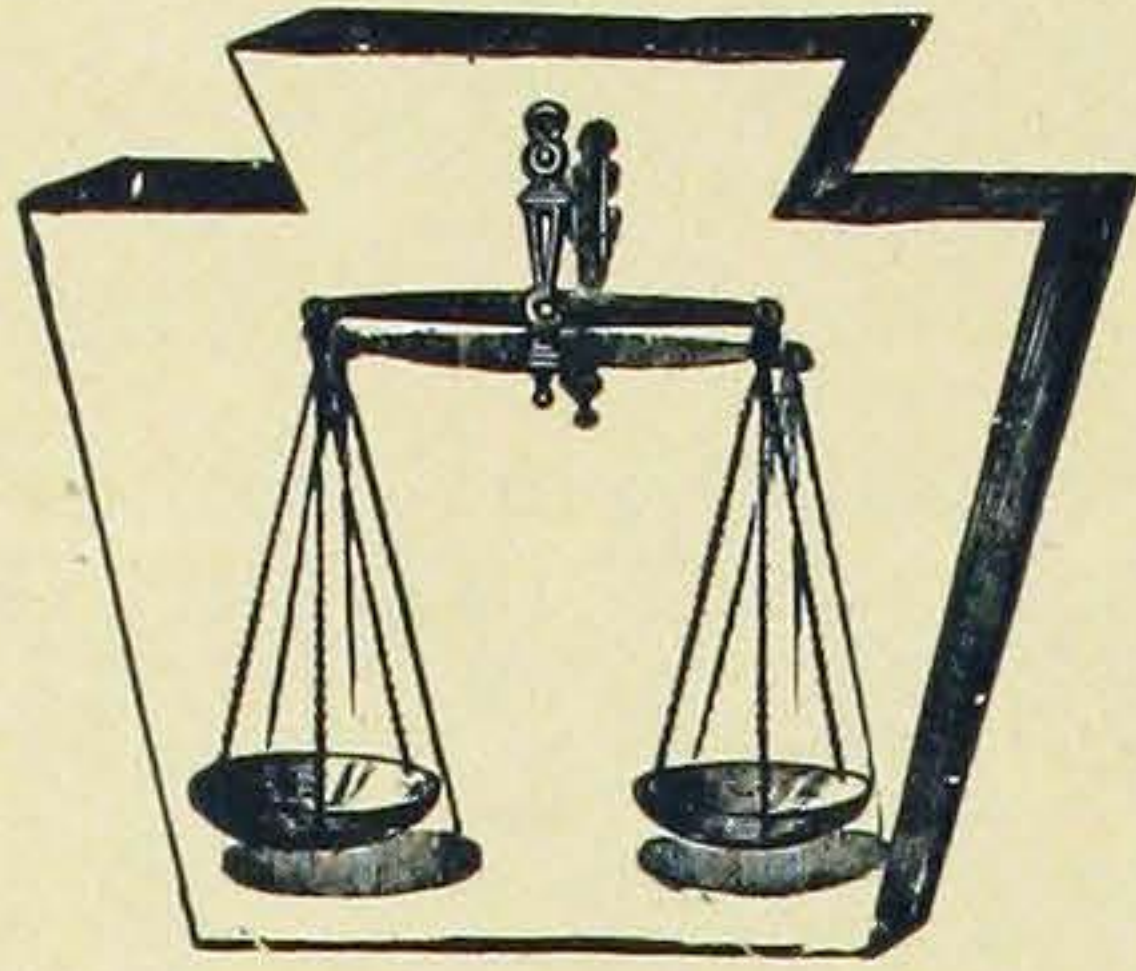

TERMS OF WARRANTY.

EACH Saw is warranted perfectly true, or as true as it is possible to make it, free from flaws and seams. If found to be defective in either of these particulars, it may be returned, and if on examination we are satisfied the saw is at fault, all necessary repairs will be made free of charge, or a new saw will be given in exchange, provided it is returned within sixty days from delivery.

The practice of using a cold-chisel or punch for retooling a saw is almost certain to distort or crack the plate, and **corners filed square in the gullet of the tooth will frequently produce the same result**, particularly in frosty weather. Our warranty does not cover saws breaking from either of these causes.
