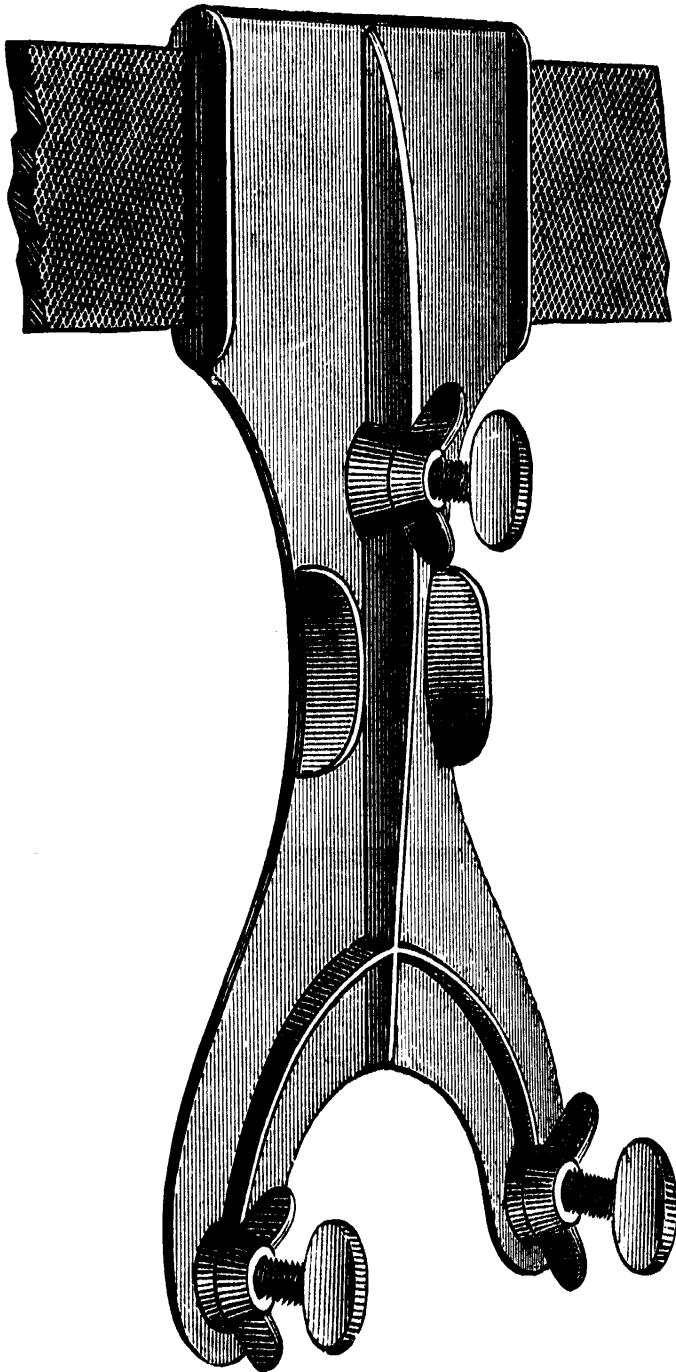


## HENRY DISSTON & SONS' IMPROVED SIDE FILE.



The Side File is used for the purpose of regulating Saw Teeth after they have been set. It is impossible to set a Saw so that some of the Teeth will not extend or be bent over a little more than others, and thus make rough lumber. By the use of this instrument all the Teeth are made even, and a Saw thus regulated will run twice as long without sharpening. The File must be so adjusted by means of the set-screws as to conform to any width of set desired. The jam-nuts are for the purpose of securing the set-screws in the desired position.
